### **Centre for Distance and Online Education**

The Centre for Distance and Online Education was established in 2020 with the primary aim of providing comprehensive online programmes in accordance with the UGC (ODL & OL) Regulations of 2020. These online programmes will adopt a fully digital approach from inception to completion. Degrees conferred upon completion of these programmes will be considered equivalent to undergraduate and postgraduate degrees obtained through traditional means.

The Centre is authorised to admit students in two sessions per calendar year, January and July, through online channels.

### **Programme Mode**

The programme will be exclusively offered in a fully online format. All academic engagements will be facilitated through the Learning Management System (LMS) of mguonline, granting students access throughout the duration of the programme. Enrolled students are expected to actively engage in online learning activities, complete assignments and participate in examinations to fulfill the programme's requirements in accordance with University regulations and course specifications.

### **Programme Delivery System**

The entire teaching-learning process shall be conducted online through the Learning Management System (LMS) in a four quadrant approach. It encompasses of :

- Recorded video lectures.
- Self learning materials.
- Live interactive sessions / discussion forums
- Assessment
  - > Internal assessments (Assignments, Quizzes, Test papers, Seminars, etc.)
  - > External assessments (remote proctored online end-semester examination)

Online programmes shall also include components like projects, viva and internships according to the syllabus, and these shall also be undertaken and completed by the students on a virtual mode as per the topics assigned to them.

To be eligible to appear for the end-semester examination, the students shall have a minimum participation of 75 % in all the activities of the online programme.



# **Overview of the Programme**

The programme aims to develop students' competence with reference to Literatures/Narratives in English, and also an awareness regarding both the historicity and contemporaneity of 'language/communication' and its interdisciplinary and global cultural aftermaths. The programme prepares students to reflect on the social and ethical dimensions of research and for careers in secondary and higher education, content development, creative visualizations, publishing, and translation.



# **Eligibility**

Graduation in English or graduation in other faculties of language and literature, social science, science, oriental studies are eligible for admission:

- 1. **Graduation in English**: 45% or equivalent CGPA for the Core group (core + open + complementary courses). If it is less than 45% then the CGPA (or its percentage) for the common course (Part I) is taken, provided he/she has secured a minimum of 50% marks in Part I.
- 2. Other faculties of language and literature, social science, science, oriental studies:
  Graduates should possess a minimum CGPA equivalent to 50% of marks in common course (Part I) and secure a minimum CGPA equivalent to 45% of marks in Part III/Core group (core + open + complementary courses).
- 3. Students from faculties such as Language and Literature other than English, Social Sciences, Science, and Oriental Studies must have successfully completed the common course (Part I), out of a minimum of 300 marks or 19 credits.

# Eligibility criteria for reservation categories

The eligibility for admissions and reservation of seats to the Programmes shall be in accordance with the norms/ rules made by the Government/ University from time to time.

Presently, the applicable relaxation is as follows:

#### **Kerala Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe Category:**

The minimum requirement for admission to UG/PG programmes is a pass in the plus two/eligible degree or equivalent for the Kerala Scheduled caste Scheduled tribe category.

#### **Kerala SEBC Category:**

A relaxation of 3% marks in the eligible degree or equivalent from the prescribed minimum is allowed.

#### **Kerala OEC Category:**

A relaxation of 5% marks in the eligible degree or equivalent from the prescribed minimum is allowed.

#### Persons with Disability category:

The minimum requirement for admission to UG/PG programmes is a pass in the plus two/eligible degree.

- The eligibility of the candidates who have acquired a plus two from other states/qualifying degree from other Universities (for students outside India as well) shall be verified by the University and the admission shall be regularized thereafter.
- There shall be no age limit for applying to the programmes offered by the Centre for Distance and Online Education.



# **Application Process**

- 1. Visit cdoe.mgu.ac.in
- 2. Register with email and phone number.
- 3. Login with the credentials received via email
- 4. Fill the application form Personal, Academic details etc. & upload supporting documents
- 5. Upload Scanned Photograph
- 6. Application fee payment.
- 7. Preview & Submit your application.

(On verification of the application, if candidate found eligible he/she will be provisionally admitted to the programme.)

8. Login to the portal to pay the first semester fee.

(Application is successfully submitted and the candidate is admitted.)

# **Fee Refund Policy**

If any candidate decides to withdraw from the programme in which the candidate took admission, then the university shall follow the UGC and University norms for Fee refund.

# **General Regulations**

- This Prospectus has been issued in concurrence with the Admission Process for online Programme by Centre
  for Distance and Online Education, Mahatma Gandhi University, 2025 sessions and shall not be valid for any
  past or future programmes offered by the University.
- Conditions in this prospectus are subject to amendments as may be deemed necessary by the University.
- Candidates are required to go through the current prospectus carefully and acquaint themselves with all the relevant information relating to the admission process.
- Candidates are requested to visit the official website of the University www.mgu.ac.in and cdoe.mgu.ac.in for all relevant information.
- Any communication from the part of mguonline will be made via the candidate's registered email id.
- The candidate shall submit the application only after proper scrutiny of all information furnished. If the application received from the student is not complete in any respect, the student may be given provisional admission at the discretion of the University. Such students will have to submit the required eligibility documents at the earliest, upon the receipt of which their admission may be confirmed, subject to eligibility fulfilment.
- In case of any mistakes / omissions, you may request a correction in your application with relevant supporting documents via the email id mguonline@mgu.ac.in at any time.



- If required, the University may conduct online meetings with the candidate at any point of time during the course of study for the verification of the eligibility documents. Non-compliance of the same may result in cancellation of admission. Any discrepancies in the certificates furnished or claims made in the application shall lead to rejection of candidature and may subsequently lead to blacklisting of the candidate / initiate criminal proceedings.
- Hard copies of the application form and enclosures need not to be sent to the University
- Payment of fee during the admission process and in subsequent semesters shall be undertaken by
  the candidates within the timelines announced by the University and failure to complete the same
  may invalidate the admission / registration at any point. Fee payment via offline modes shall not be
  entertained.
- The University reserves the right to amend the syllabus, programme structure, rules and regulations whenever considered necessary and appropriate for the smooth conduct of the programme without any prior notice.
- All sort of official communication from the University shall be through LMS after getting admission to the programme.
- If the application is complete in all respects and mguonline is satisfied with the applicant's eligibility and suitability for admission into the respective online programme, the student will be granted admission to that programme.





# Validity of the Admission / Registration

- Similar to the offline programmes, the online Post Graduate programmes shall have a 2 year / 4 semester duration. If a student does not complete all programme requirements within the specified duration, the student is expected to complete the programme within 4 years from the date of admission. Additional examination fee shall be applicable for every additional attempts.
- The online B.Com (Hons) programme shall have a 4 year / 8 semester duration. If a student does not complete all programme requirements within the specified duration, the student is expected to complete the programme within 7 years from the date of admission. Additional examination fee shall be applicable for every additional attempts.
